As a user of Bonsall Village Hall, we will provide access to Wi-Fi as long as you accept the policy below. Your usage of the Bonsall Village Hall Wi-Fi facility and the network is regulated by relevant UK law. If anything is unclear, please contact us at admin@bonsallvillagehall.co.uk.

Acceptable Use: You may **not** use the facilities for

- Unlawful or illegal activity.
- Commercial purposes, unless authorised in writing by the Bonsall Village Hall Management Committee.
- Access, send or otherwise make available to others any material that is offensive, obscene or indecent, hacking, computer viruses or that infringes the copyright of people.
- Breaching confidentiality or intellectual property rights by making available by any means, any material, unless you are the copyright holder of that material, or have the licence to make that material available, or the material has been expressly put into the public domain and you can demonstrate this.
- Access network services in such a way as to deny reasonable access to the network for other users by, for example, excessive use of network bandwidth for music or video streaming or very large downloads.
- Create or transmit any material designed or likely to cause annoyance, inconvenience, or needless anxiety.
